Over the past few weeks Mason Madej who has been moving through the Rotax ranks the last few years has just earned the titles of; 2008 Jr Max division Champion in the MRP Rotax Challenge. Along with 2008 Jr Max division Champion in the Michiana Raceway Park Championship series. Mason is also currently ranked the #1 Rotax Max Jr Driver in the United States Rotax Kart Challenge National Points Standings. Mason has been building his resume over the last four years which includes three consecutive Mazda Jr indoor karting championships at Chicago Indoor Racing; now one of his sponsors. Mason was runner up in the Rotax Mini Max division for the 2006 MRP Rotax Challenge and 2006 Michiana Raceway Park Championship Series. Mason's love for racing started many years ago and since becoming hands on involved in 2005 Mason has accumulated multiple race wins and pole position starts, along with several track records.
